The *Journal of the Society for Musicology in Ireland* (JSMI) protects the personal data of the Journal's registered users in accordance with the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR, from May 2018): for explanation and guidance, see http://gdprandyou.ie/resources/

By registering an account as a user of JSMI you assent to all the following aspects of the journal's policy:

The personal data that JSMI holds

- JSMI collects and holds only the data that you permit us to have when you register as a user of the JSMI website and complete your profile, whether as a reader, or reviewer or in any other role. Some additional personal information (e.g. biographical details, your public ORCID code) is typically submitted and held when, as a registered user, you make a submission to the journal site as an author or potential author.
- As a registered user you may see what personal data JSMI holds by logging in and viewing your profile page. If you are an author you may review your submission data by going to your dashboard page.
- Most fields in your account settings are optional: you may choose to supply such data about yourself or not. The only essential ones are your first name, last name, your country of residence and an email address.

Changing or deleting your personal data

- All the data that you have access to in your profile and dashboard pages may be edited by you directly. Your existing account username is the only field that cannot be altered. If you need assistance with updating any information, please contact the JSMI site manager (email: jsmi@musicologyireland.com).
- You have the right to have your user-account deleted and all your data removed from our records. You may request this by contacting the JSMI site manager (email: jsmi@musicologyireland.com).

The public display of personal details

- If you are registered with JSMI as a reader or reviewer, none of your personal details is shown to visitors to the JSMI site.
- In the case of an author: by making a submission to the journal you grant to JSMI the right to display in this open-access journal all relevant personal data (your full name, institutional affiliation, biographical or career details, an email address, your ORCID,

etc.) when publishing your work and to maintain the visibility of that information on a permanent basis.

Notifications and communication

- As a registered user of JSMI, you may receive various communications and announcements about the journal: some emails are generated and sent out automatically by the software system (for example when a new volume is published).
- JSMI reserves the right to communicate with you by email on all important matters. However, in the case of routine matters, you may control which sorts of notifications and emails that you receive from JSMI: go to the 'Notifications' tab on your profile page.
- The names and email addresses of registered users of JSMI will be used exclusively for the stated purposes of this journal and will not be made available for any other purpose or to any other party.
